### 1992 RECIPIENT

Michele Simmons of Hendrix College is the winner of the Arkansas Inter-collegiate Conference 1992 Downing-Swift-Wallace Scholar-Athlete Award.

Simmons lettered in volleyball at Hendrix College during each of her four years at the college. She is a May graduate summa cum laude, and earned a bachelor of arts degree with distinction from the Economics and Business Department, with a 4.00 grade point average.

Simmons was co-captain of the volleyball team during her junior and senior years, and was a strong hitter, server, passer, and all-around player. She was known by her hard work and intense play in practice, as well as in matches.

In addition, she received five awards from the college.

1. A Carl Babcock Award for Leadership in Athletics, which is awarded by the Athletic Advisory Committee to the varsity athletes who have, during the past year, most nearly exemplified the ideals for which Carl Babcock stood — clean and vigorous competition, the pursuit of excellence, dedication to physical health and well-being, team above self, honor above victory.

2. A Scholarship Prize which is offered by the Arkansas Alpha Chapter of Alpha Chi Scholarship Society to the highest ranking senior members of Alpha Chi.

3. The E. W. Martin Memorial Accounting Award which is offered by friends of the late Mr. Martin to the student who has done outstanding work in accounting and has demonstrated leadership in the community.

4. The Mosley Economics and Business Award which was established by the late Ellis G. Mosley and is offered to a student studying economics and business who, during the senior year, ranked highest in departmental courses and on the comprehensive examination.

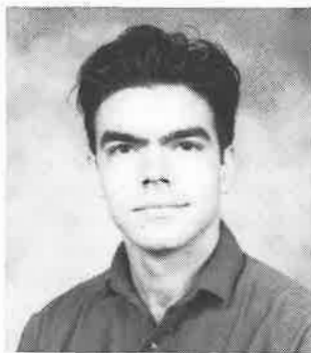

### 1992 RECIPIENT

Doug Goodman of Henderson State University is the winner of the Arkansas Inter-collegiate Conference 1992 Cliff Shaw Scholar-Athlete Award.

Goodman, an August graduate of Henderson State University with a 3.61 grade point average with a major in recreation, is a four-year letterman for the HSU baseball team.

A righthanded pitcher, Goodman signed a free agent contract with St. Louis Cardinals after his senior season.

Goodman tied a school record with 10 wins his senior season, when he completed 12 of the 13 games he started. Goodman had a 1.53 earned run average his senior season, when he struck out 62 and walked just 35 in 82½ innings of action.

As a junior, Goodman completed all 14 games he started - one short of the NAIA record — and posted eight wins while pitching a school record 106½ innings. He was a two-time All-AIC selection and was a unanimous All-Conference pick his senior season. Also, he was one of just three players from Arkansas chosen to the All-Area II squad, and was an honorable mention All-American his senior season.

In addition to his athletic accomplishments, Goodman was a member of the Henderson Singers, active in the Missionary Baptist Student Fellowship, was a member of the Recreation Club and served as a member of the Red and Gray Line, a student orientation group.

Doug is the son of major and Mrs. John G. Goodman of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.
