#### A. I. C. AWARD TO ARKANSAS A & M ATHLETE

Gerald Partridge, a two-year football letterman at Arkansas A & M College, was winner of the 1960 Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference outstanding Scholar-Athlete award.

Partridge compiled a scholastic average of 3.57 in his college work. The average was compiled on a basis of 4.0 for a mark of "A", 3.0 for "B", 2.0 for "C", 1.0 for "D" and zero for "F".

Runners-up were Henry L. McQueen of Harding College, 3.31; Winston Bryant of Ouachita College, 3.26, and Ernie Martin of Hendrix College, 2.55.
